

## **PCMA SEWAGE RATES**

### **Effective September 1, 2022**

#### **SEWAGE RATES – September 1, 2022**

- Septic Tank Empty (Pump) & Inspect - **\$455.00**
- Holding Tank Empty (Pump) - **\$455.00**
- Holding Tank Test - **\$110.00**
- Additional Sewage Charges: \$50.00 per hour additional in excess of 2 hours. \$50.00 for every additional length of pump hose needed if the distance from the tank to the pumping location is over 50 feet. \$50.00 for every 10 feet of elevation over the first 10 feet. Pumps performed on weekends, holidays, and after regular working hours are charged double. \$50.00 additional if a septic tank has a lid inside the riser that must be removed and replaced in order to pump the tank. **Pumps called in at or after 12:00 NOON on weekdays** will be charged double if the pumping can't wait until the next business day. In other words, if you call for a pump at or after 12:00 noon during a regular work week, and you can't wait until the next business day to have your tank pumped, you will be charged double.

Septic systems are required to be pumped and inspected once every three years. Holding tanks are required to be tested once every three years.
